



A personal timeline is a plan of standard anti-disaster activities to take before major rains or typhoons. Prepare for these events, and check your actions daily. This timeline is a standard, basic procedure aimed against wind and water hazards. City information depends on details of weather and geography, and may not always follow this exact order, so please be careful.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Possibility of an alert</li> <li>◆ <b>Level 2:</b></li> <li>Rain watch, flood watch, wind watch</li> <li>* Rain becomes strong</li> </ul>	<p>This is an announcement from Ebina City. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Rain alert (mudslide, inundation risk), flood alert, wind alert</li> <li>* River levels begin to rise</li> </ul>	<p><b>Confirm the status of evacuation centers!</b></p> <p>City home pages, Ebina mail services, tvk broadcasts etc. can show which evacuation centers are open.</p> <p>tvk Data Broadcast</p>	<p><b>When to evacuate? →</b></p> <p>(If your home is within the evacuation recommendation or order area, evacuate now)</p>
Several hours before	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* <b>River levels reach the evacuation level</b></li> <li>* Press releases from the meteorological agency regarding typhoons (the highest level of alerts)</li> </ul>	<p><b>Warning level 3</b></p> <p>Evacuation preparation/start of evacuating elderly people.</p> <p>Older people and others who need time to evacuate, as well as those helping them (family etc.), <b>should begin to evacuate.</b></p> <p>In areas where there is a mudslide risk, or the possibility of a sudden rise in water level, <b>evacuate to evacuation centers etc. as soon as you are prepared.</b></p>	<p><b>What to do when evacuating?</b></p> <p>(Place a check mark once you've done it)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Be alert for the status of your surroundings, and disaster prevention information.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Confirm the status of your local evacuation center ( _____ )</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Tell friends and family to evacuate to ( _____ )</p> <p>Confirm that fires are out and doors are closed</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Evacuate to the homes of nearby friends or family</p> <p>Begin full evacuation</p>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Rain becomes heavier</li> <li>◆ Mudslide warning information</li> <li>* <b>River levels reach the overflow risk level</b></li> </ul>	<p><b>Warning level 4</b></p> <p>Evacuate order (urgent)/advisory</p> <p>Evacuate quickly to evacuation centers etc. (Evacuation complete)</p> <p>The situation is <b>extremely dangerous</b> and a disaster could occur at any moment. <b>People who have not evacuated yet should do so immediately.</b></p>	<p><b>Protect your life!</b></p> <p>If you determine the route to the evacuation center is too dangerous, protect yourself by moving to higher ground or upper level immediately</p>
When you see the projected rain areas from a typhoon making landfall, or similar events	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Information on record short-term rains</li> <li>◆ Special rain alert Overflow announcements</li> </ul>	<p><b>Warning level 5</b></p> <p>Disaster information</p> <p><b>A disaster has already occurred. Do whatever is best to protect your own life.</b></p>
